



Dr. Nynne Capion is Assistant Professor of Medicine and Surgery at the University Hospital for Large Animals at University of Copenhagen. She received her DVM in 2001 from the Royal Veterinary and Agricultural University of Copenhagen. Dr. Capion was educated claw trimmer in 2000. Since 2001 Dr. Capion has been performing research within claw health and lameness. The recent 4 years the primary focus on her research has been digital dermatitis.

Nynne Capion consults dairies about lameness, control of claws lesions and related risk factors.

Dr. Capion frequently hosts seminars and practical workshops for veterinarians, claw trimmers, farmers and feeding consultants.

In 2008 Dr. Capion was the founder and teacher of a new education for claw trimmers. She is a member of the Danish claw trimmer association.
